What is a Judeo-Christian Worldview?

There is no universal agreement on the definition of "Judeo-Christian", beyond the obvious religious meaning that Judaism and Christianity are related and that the latter grew out of the former.

However, as a worldview, "Judeo-Christian" implies a certain understanding of the nature of the world in which we live. That understanding can be summarized as follows:

- 1. There is one God who created everything including human beings.
- 2. That God transcends or sits outside creation but is actively involved in it.
- 3. All humans are created equal in worth which is the basis of democracy.
- 4. Humans have been given dominion over the rest of creation.
- 5. All humans are created with a free will and therefore, only by adhering to the Creator's basic principles of love, tolerance and justice can society be at peace and function as intended.
